## **WEROONA HOME**

Weroona, a Home at Woodford in the Blue Mountains, has had many lives. It started life as a private residence in the early 20<sup>th</sup> Century. It then became a Home for retired Methodist Ministers, a guest house, a residence for the children from Burnside, Parramatta, during the Second World War, a Boy's Home from 1946 to 1984, a Home for Indigenous Youth and then a Home for disabled adults.

It is now back in private hands and is the subject of a research project on the relationship between private and public philanthropy in NSW. The research is being conducted on behalf of Prof John Croucher of Macquarie University.

Former residents can make a valuable contribution to this research by sharing their stories and recollections.
