Redress WA

Acknowledging the past

Redress WA is a WA Government initiative to assist adults who, as children, were abused while in care in WA, both institutional and non-institutional (including Child Migrants and Stolen Generation), prior to 1 March 2006.

Redress WA includes an opportunity to apply for an *ex gratia* payment and receive an official apology from the State Government.

Care Leavers Australia Network (CLAN) can assist you to access the Redress WA scheme if you now live in another state or overseas.

Some of the support that CLAN Redress WA can provide:

- Practical assistance in completing Redress WA applications either by telephone, email or in person;
- Counselling and emotional support through the application process;
- Problem solving, advice and information;
- Referral to services such as counselling, self help groups, health, housing;
- Referral for Financial counselling and budgeting.

All Redress WA applications need to be lodged by **30 April 2009**
